### **Purpose**

#### What?

Menstrual Hygiene Day is an annual awareness day on May 28 that highlights the importance of good menstrual hygiene management (MHM) at a global level. It was initiated by the German-based NGO WASH United in 2013 and observed for the first time in 2014. A hybrid summit Saturday May 27 with family-friendly awareness activities Why?

Choices of menstrual hygiene materials are often limited by the costs, availability and social norms. Adequate sanitation facilities and access to feminine hygiene products are important but having open discussions about adequate education for women and girls is of equal importance. Research has found that not having access to menstrual hygiene management products can keep girls home from school during their period each month.

#### Goals

Menstrual Hygiene Day is an occasion for publicizing information, including social media and engaging decision-makers. The day aims to advocate for integrating menstrual hygiene management into global, national, and local policies and programs.

#### How?

By bringing together different organizations in Oklahoma and the diaspora to push out the information and garner resources to educate and dispense necessary items to allow girls in the community to feel safe and know what to do when they are menstruating.

We offer alternatives to help with cramping and Period pains, such as Yoga lessons and exercise. Ideas for dietary options for and around their cycle.

Ways to self-care and resources to follow up with.






